

2019 Cornerstone Journal Call For Submissions!

The UCR Department of History is now accepting submissions for the 2019 undergraduate historical journal, *Cornerstone*. The Cornerstone Journal recognizes excellence in undergraduate writing, and publishes original research completed by students in UCR History courses.

Eligibility: All papers of TEN double-spaced pages or longer that have been written for ANY undergraduate history course (Spring 2018 - present) are eligible for submission. The award is open to ALL actively enrolled undergraduates of ANY major who have written a paper for a UCR history course.

Application: Papers should be submitted via email (history@ucr.edu) in advance of the deadline, and include a Department of History Award Application form. All entries will become the property of the UCR Department of History.

Award Selection: Papers will be judged by a panel of faculty and graduate students who will select the top three to four essays for publication in Cornerstone. **An award of \$300** will be made to the first-place winner. Announcement of awards will be made in mid-late April. Presentations of awards will take place at a luncheon on May 31, 2018. Students selected to be published in the Cornerstone Journal will be required to briefly present their paper at the awards luncheon.
