

Fall 2019 KEN R. NOLLER UNDERGRADUATE AWARD IN HISTORY

The UCR Department of History is pleased to announce the Fall 2019 Ken R. Noller Undergraduate Student Award in History. An award of \$1000 will be made to support freshman or community college transfer students with financial need majoring in History.

Eligibility: The award is open to all freshman and community college transfer students majoring in History, History/Administrative Studies, or History/Law and Society. Preference will be given to students who are first in their families to attend college, and who have expressed interest in becoming a teacher. No minimum GPA required.

<u>Application</u>: A personal statement essay between one and three pages describing personal, academic and career goals. Essays must be submitted via email (history@ucr.edu), and include a Department of History Noller Award Application form in advance of the deadline.

<u>Award Selection</u>: Nominations will be reviewed and selected by the History Undergraduate Faculty Advisor. An award of \$1,000 will be made to the top two candidates. The department is not obligated to make an award should no outstanding applications be received. Announcement and distribution of awards will be made in January, 2020. All award winners are required to attended the Department of History awards luncheon in May 2020. More information to follow.
